



ANNUAL DAY USE PASS

- 1. This annual pass provides day use entrance to any park location for the registered cardholder(s) when presenting this card and a valid photo ID.
- 2. This pass is not refundable and will not be replaced if lost or stolen. It is unlawful to alter or copy this pass.
- 3. Day use entrance means a single vehicle with up to 4 adults. It does not provide access to campground areas or amenities.
- 4. Annual passes do not include additional costs for tours, special events or programs.
- 5. Restrictions apply: see <u>azstateparks.com</u> or visit one of our parks for complete details.
