

D2(d): Becky Bouquot, Arizona Elk Society gave the Board an overview of the Arizona Elk Society program. The mission of this exciting program is to offer children a chance to experience the great outdoors, develop a lifelong passion for elk and other wildlife. They rely on grants and donations for habitant conservation, restoration and to preserve hunting heritage for future generations.

John Sefton moved to approve consent agenda item D2(d) funding for the 2023 Heritage Fund Environmental Education grant application as follows: Arizona Elk Society's Youth Education Project in the amount of \$50,000.00. Sarah King seconded the motion. Dale Larsen approved. John Sefton approved. Jeff Buchanan abstained. Sarah King approved. Terri Palmberg approved. The motion passed.

- **3. Pinal County Peralta Regional Park Presentation. (Presenter: Kent Taylor, Director, Open Space and Trails)** The Board was given an update on the newly opened Peralta Regional Park. The park was funded in part through Land and Water Conservation funds. The park uses a 'light touch' approach to infrastructure within the park and online technology to book reservations. The Board did not take any action.
- **4. Verde Wheel Fun Presentation. (Presenter: Kevin Adams, Verde Wheel Fun, Co-Founder and Treasurer)** The Board was given an update on the Verde Wheel Fun funded in part through the Arizona Heritage Fund grant. Their program is focused on rural Arizona after school MTB clubs. They teach the children bike skills, maintenance, trail cleanup, preservation and trail etiquette. The Board did not take any action.
- **5. Legislative Update. (Presenter: Brittany Hudson, Legislative Liaison)** *The Board was given an update on the 2023 legislative bills. The Board did not take any action.*
