The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding provides funding to assist facilities that were impacted during COVID. These funds are specifically related to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to support COVID-19 related activities in accordance with the State Fiscal Recovery Fund Expenditure Category 2.11 Aid to Tourism, Travel or Hospitality. Specifically, these funds are to be used for grants to replace or upgrade HVAC/air filtration systems to provide a safe and healthy environment for visitors during the current and post pandemic environment. A total of \$1,000,000 was made available for this program. These grants require no match and must be completed within two years of the funds being awarded.

A project sponsor may apply for up to 20% of these available funds or \$200,000.00
