## **Courthouse Special Event and Wedding Information**

Special events and weddings are over and above our normal operation as a museum therefore we require a reservation of time and place. We can offer two different wedding program options.

Weddings with 20 or fewer people can be hosted here at the Courthouse museum during business hours. We do not close off any areas during museum operations to other museum patrons. Fees for these events are as follows:

Business Hours Non-Private Wedding Fees	
Special Use Fee (includes admission for	\$75
up to 10 people)	
Additional Visitors (max 20 people total)	\$100

Private wedding events can only be hosted after museum hours. The event must conclude within 1 ½ hours of closing time the day of the event. Fees for these events are as follows:

After Hours Private Wedding Fees	
Private Wedding	Up to 20 Guests
Up to 1 1/2 Hour Function	Starts at \$250

To reserve your wedding date, please contact the Park's Event Coordinator to confirm your date, time, guest information, and to acquire a Wedding Reservation form.

Private events (non-weddings over 20 guests) require an Arizona State Parks & Trails Special Use Permit Application as well as Tombstone Courthouse Event Planning form submitted to Park Staff. Upon approval of the Special Use Permit, a deposit payment must be made to secure reservation and a Certificate of Insurance must be provided to the Park. The entire event fees must be paid in full a minimum of two weeks prior to event and are refundable (excluding the deposit) with a minimum of a 24-hour notice. For Special Event fees please contact the Event Coordinator. If you are unsure if the Private event requirements apply to you, contact the Park directly.

All events are subject to museum rules including:
No animals, except service animals, are allowed in the building
No Food or Drink other than Water in the building
No Firearms – No Real Flowers Permitted

**Important**: No Lift or Elevator available to get to second floor where the courtroom is located.
