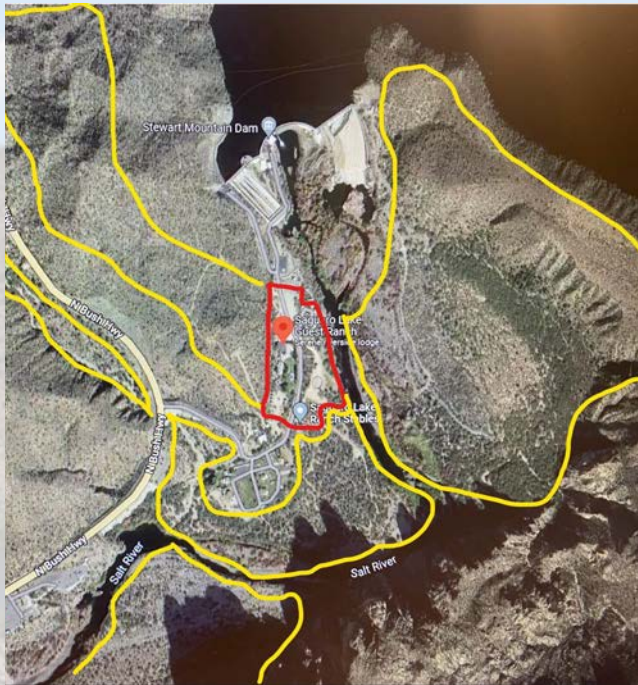

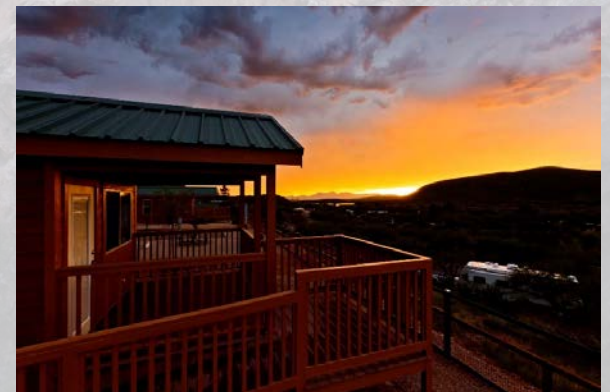
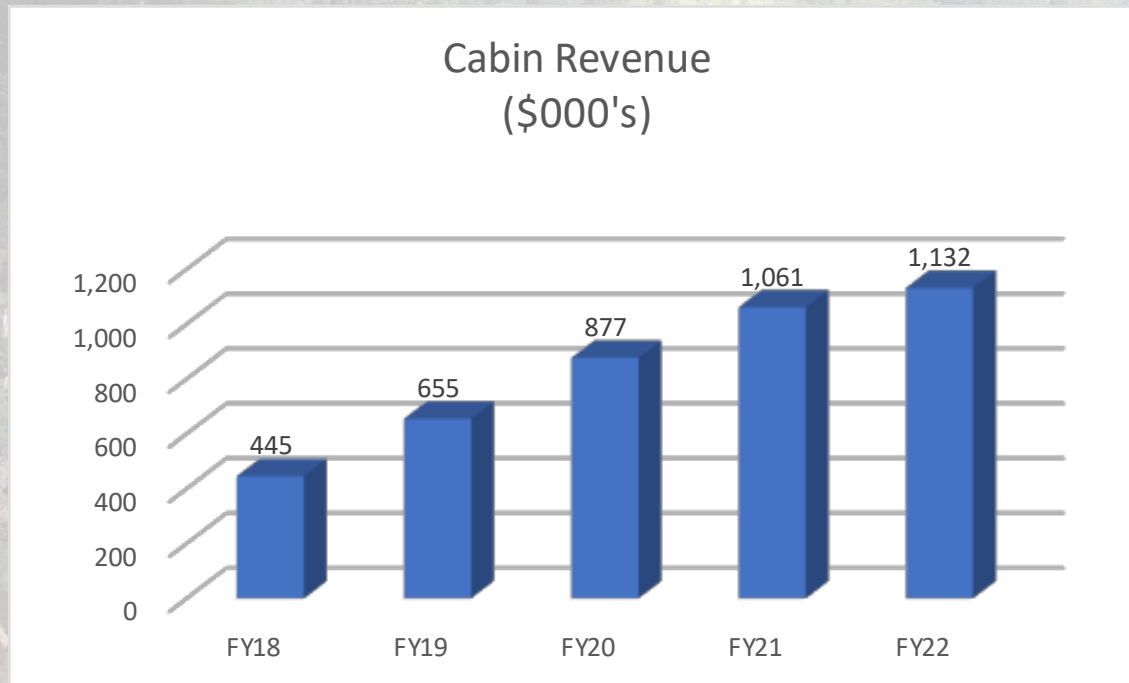


- There are 57 Cabins at 8 different parks
