Kartchner Caverns State Park Group Visit Policy Acknowledgement Receipt

Before arriving for your cave tour at Kartchner Caverns State Park, please read and acknowledge the following information. This information will help us preserve and protect the cave and ensure that you have a good experience during your visit. Each person must bring the signed form with them on their tour to hand in at the park.

Please check in at the front desk of the Discovery Center no less than one hour before your scheduled tour.

In order to provide the highest level of safety, while protecting the caverns' natural resources, the following items are **not permitted** on your tour:

- Purses, packs, or bags of any kind
- Food, drink, water, candy, chewing tobacco, or gum
- **CELL PHONES**, cameras, or any electronic devices
- Strollers, binoculars, or flashlights
- E-cigarettes or vaporizers

Lockers are available to store your items until you return from your cavern tour.

You will be inside the cavern with a guide for approximately one hour and will walk about half a mile at a slow pace. Our caverns are 72 degrees Fahrenheit and 99% humidity year-round, so you do not need a jacket on your tour.

The trails through the caverns are smooth and wheelchair accessible. We do have wheelchairs that may be used, but you must provide the person to push the wheelchair.
