

<u>Frequently Asked Questions</u> For New OHV Education Mandates

Question: How many times do I have to take the course if I have multiple OHVs registered to me? Answer: Completing the course one (1) time will allow you to register all OHVs registered to you.

Question: Do I have to take the course every time I want to renew my OHV decal? *Answer:* No, you only have to take it once.

Question: What is the cost for the mandatory OHV Education course? *Answer:* The course is free

Question: Is the course required for every OHV operator in the state of Arizona? *Answer:* No, it is only required to obtain a resident or non-resident OHV decal.

Question: How long does it take to complete the test? Answer: The video is approximately 10 minutes and it is followed by a 20-question test that takes approximately 5 minutes to complete.

Question: How do non-residents complete the course? Answer: By following this <u>non-resident step-by-step guide</u> and completing the course in your <u>AZGFD Portal</u> account.

Question: How do residents complete the course?

Answer: By following this <u>resident step-by-step guide</u> and completing the course in your <u>AZMVD</u> <u>Now</u> account

Question: Is the education course required for every operator in the state of Arizona? *Answer:* No, only the person registering and/or obtaining an OHV decal.

Question: When does the requirement take effect? Answer: January 1st, 2025, however MVD is hosting the course on their website now, where residents can take the course early if they choose.

Question: Can I take the course early without initiating a registration? *Answer:* Yes, residents can take the course early on the MVD Now website. Non-residents will be able to take the course on the G&F website starting on January 1st, 2025.

Question: What type of certification will I be issued? *Answer:* No certification will be provided.

<u>Question: and what proof of completion do I need to provide?</u> <u>Answer: Proof of completion will reside within the AZMVD Now system for residents and the</u> <u>Arizona Game and Fish Department Portal Account for non-residents.</u>
