



Mandatory Requirements for Guided Moonlight Hikes

All participants must review and adhere to the following mandatory requirements.

Non-compliance will result in the denial of participation in the guided hike.

Requirement	Condition
Minimum Age	All participants shall be a minimum of twelve (12) years of age.
Pets	The presence of any pets is strictly prohibited. Pets may not be left unattended within personal vehicles.
Lighting	Each participant should bring and carry a functional flashlight or headlamp. The use of a cell phone as the sole source of illumination is strongly discouraged.
Footwear	Only closed-toed, appropriate hiking footwear shall be worn by all participants.
Hydration	Participants are required to bring and carry adequate water. Water bottles may be replenished at the Visitor Center before the guided hike begins.
Park Access	Following regular operating hours, access to and presence within the park shall be strictly limited to individuals officially registered for the guided hike. Dropping off or picking up participants, as well as waiting in the parking lot for the return of the hiking group, is expressly prohibited, as park gates will be secured and closed.
Punctuality	Participants must arrive and complete check-in a minimum of twenty-five (25) minutes prior to the scheduled start time to ensure timely entry before the gate is secured. Late arrivals will be denied access and participation, as the park gates will be closed.
