SCHOOL GROUP POLICIES

PREPARATION FOR TEACHERS

Studying caves and formations prior to your visit will greatly enhance the students' overall experience. See Curriculum link on our "School Groups" page or the "Explore" tab for activities. * Please note the Jr. Ranger program is not available for school groups

Please go over our rules with all participants (including chaperones) and organize your students into groups with an assigned chaperone. The ratio of students to chaperones should never exceed 4:1.

Arrive 1 hour before your school's first tour. Group ramada reservations are usually available.

UPON ARRIVAL

Remain under the ramada at the bus drop off area to meet a Park Staff member. A chaperone must pick up tickets at the front desk an hour before your tour.

Your group will have group lockers and restrooms available for use- all prohibited items should be stowed in the lockers or kept on the bus. Students should never be alone without a chaperone, even in the Discovery Center museum, Gift Shop, and Cafe.

CAVE TOUR PROHIBITED ITEMS

* These apply to ALL participants, including chaperones and teachers

Absolutely No:

- Cell phones, Cameras
- Purses, Packs, Backpacks
- Flashlights, Binoculars
- Bottled Water, Candy, Gum, etc..
- Strollers

Wheelchairs and packs for medical devices are available. Please inquire at the front desk.

CHAPERONES

Chaperones are responsible for the behavior and safety of each student in their group. Please be attentive chaperones from the time you first get off the bus until you board the bus to leave.

School Group Rules:

- Follow Park Staff directions at all times
- No touching inside the cave
- Keep all body parts inside the tram
- Use inside voices
- No running or climbing on the walls
- Be respectful of other park guests
