Applicants will receive points if the project satisfies needs of statewide significance as determined by the most recent (2016) [Arizona Watercraft Survey](#).

In this survey, boaters responded to the question: "What are the most needed water-based recreational facilities and services?" Applicants will be awarded points according to the identified statewide needs addressed below. The maximum that can be awarded is 20 points.

Safety/Law Enforcement Enhancements are limited to: water safety facilities, marking buoys, and watercraft ("watercraft" includes only boat, trailer, motor, radios, lights, and first aid).*

A new Rogue patrol boat directly addresses the Safety/Law Enforcement Enhancement needs. Bullhead City Police Department patrols the Colorado River on the border of Arizona and Nevada. Patrol units operate from the Davis Dam (including the Davis Camp recreational area) approximately 13 miles south by the Nature Center (city limits). When needed, units will travel south further on the river to assist. The boats are also used by the Bullhead City Police Department Dive Team who conduct a variety of operations on the Colorado River and Lake Mohave. The Colorado River is highly populated during the summer months (May 1-October 1) and can be extremely dangerous to recreational activity. The patrol boat will be tasked with enforcement, emergency responses, vessel assists, visual presence, community interaction and education.

Renovation
