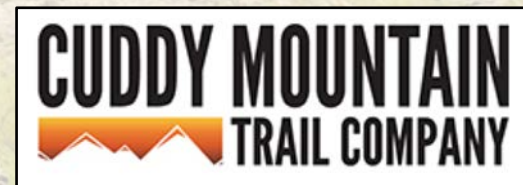

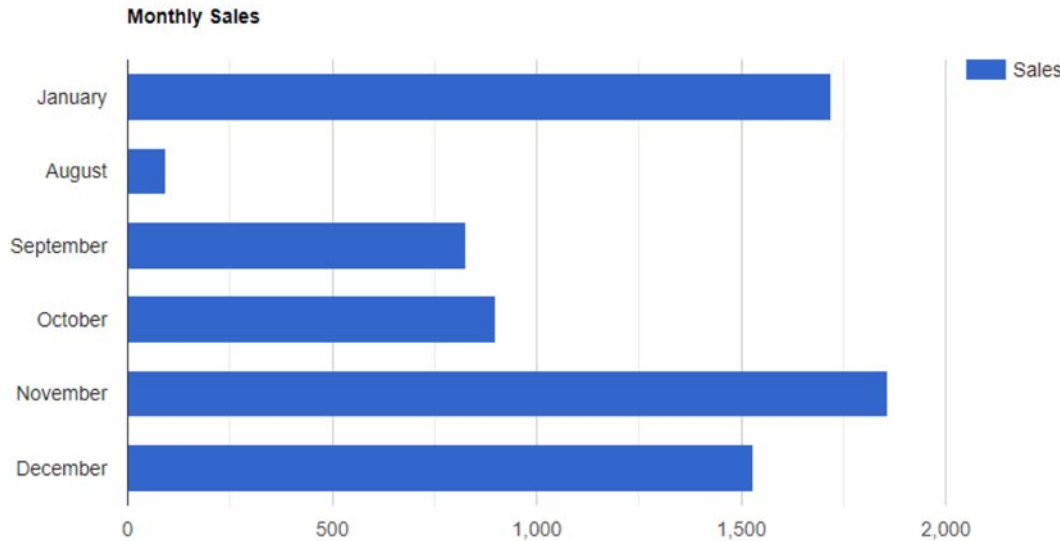

### Sales By Month

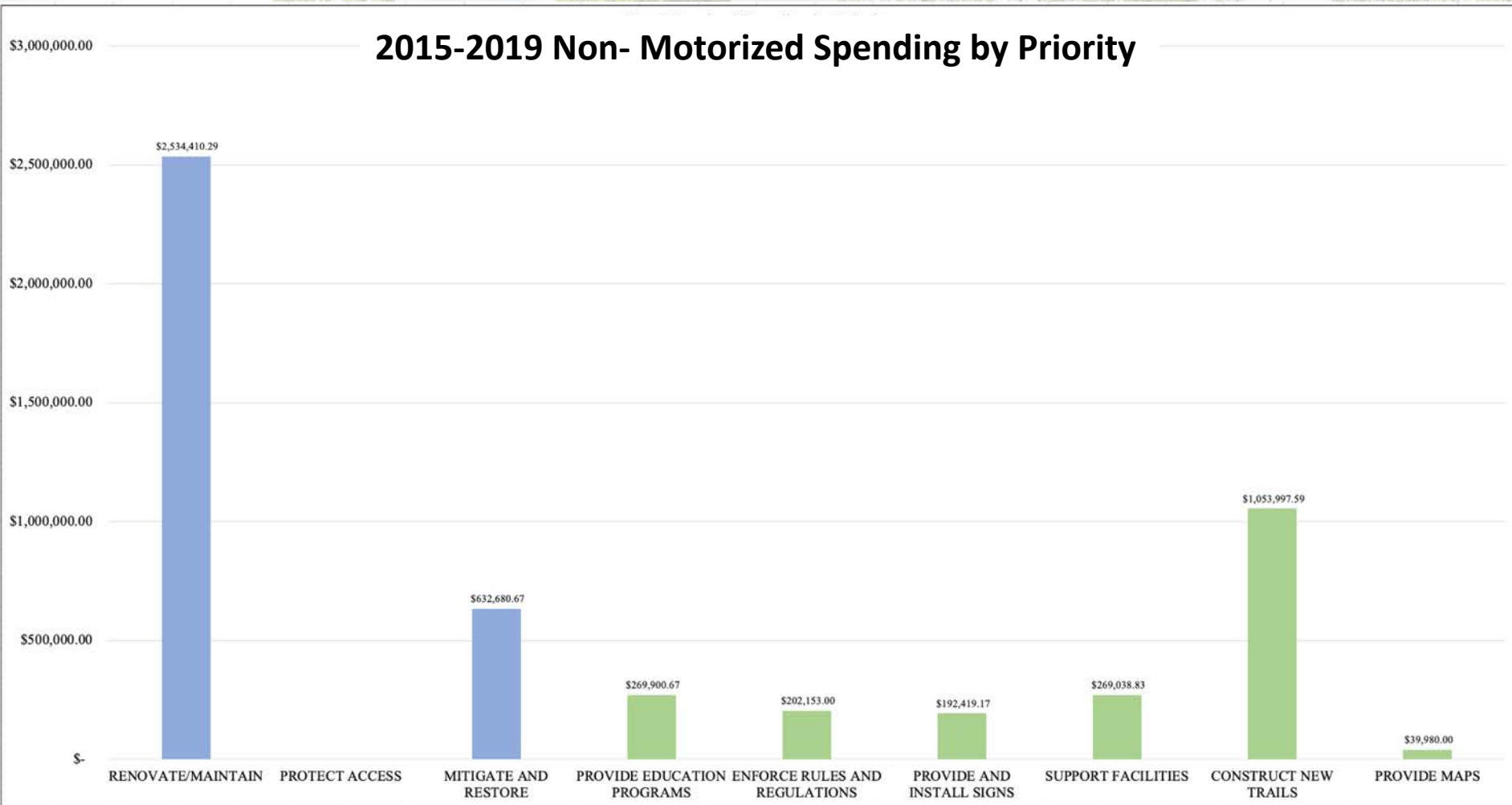

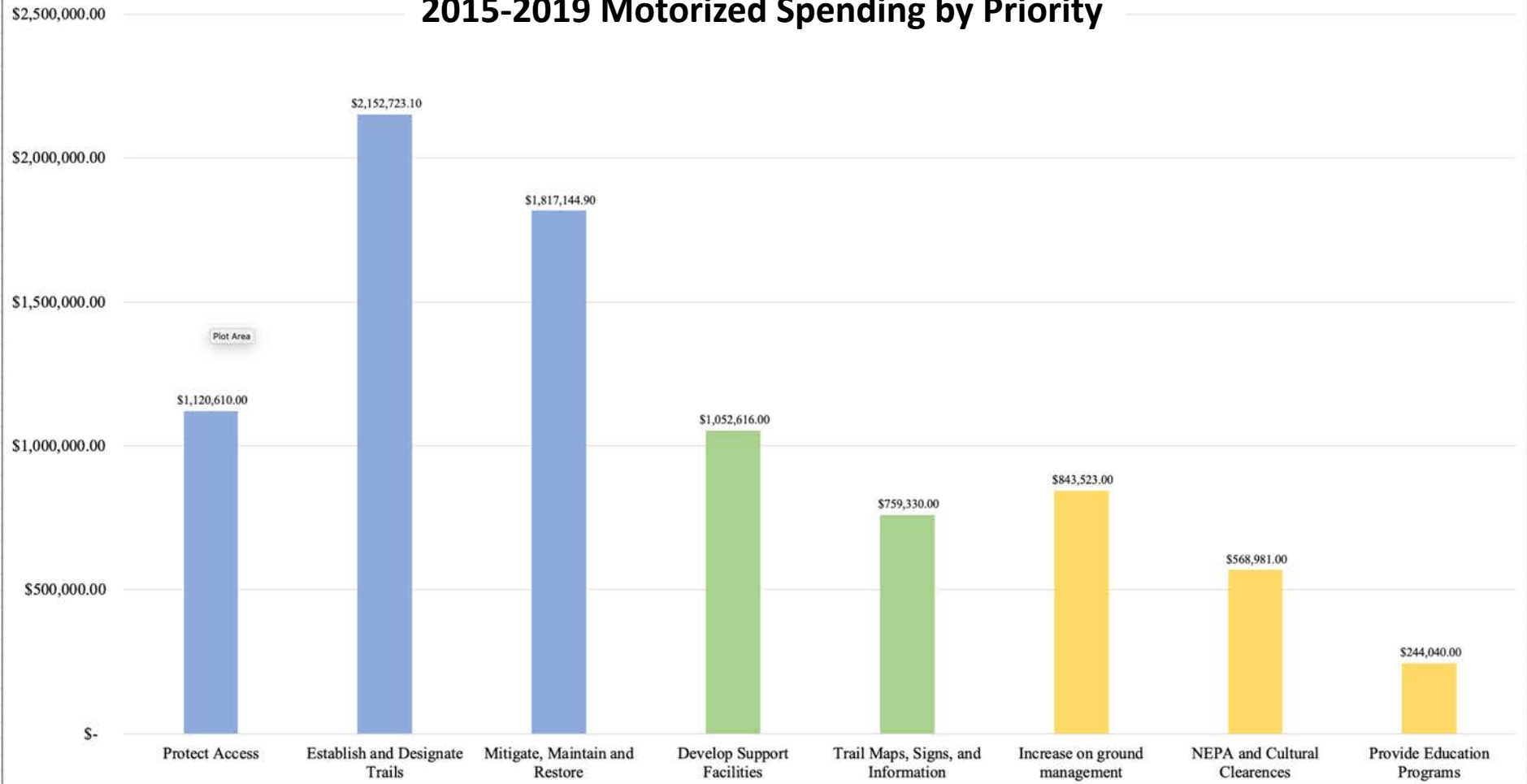
## 2015-2019 Non- Motorized Spending by Priority
