UPON ARRIVAL

The trip to the caverns should be a memorable, educational, and very amazing time. Thank you for your help in accomplishing that.

Before the school goes inside the building:

- The leader of the group needs to meet with a ranger/staff at the front desk
- Once briefed, you will need to organize and prepare the chaperones and students before entering

If the kids aren't already in groups, assign them groups.

PROHIBITED ITEMS ON CAVE TOURS

Absolutely no:

- cell phones, cameras
- purses, packs, backpacks
- flashlights, binoculars
- bottled water, candy, gum, etc..
- strollers

Wheelchairs are available. Inquire at the front desk.

CHAPERONES AND PARENTS

Even though you are on a school field trip and we want you to have a wonderful time, chaperones and parents still have a job to do, which begins when you step off the bus.

All students must be accompanied by an attentive adult at all times.

There should never be any unattended children. Chaperones are responsible for the behavior of each student in their group. Safety is our main concern. Thank you for keeping the kids safe.

The kids need your help in following the park rules, which include:

- Respect other guests that are not part of your school
- Use inside voices
- No running or climbing on the walls Adults should lead by example and not have a cell phone anywhere on tour, not even in a pocket!

GROUP LOCKERS ARE AVAILABLE

A group leader should inquire at the front desk for the combination. Regular lockers are also available for parents/ chaperones. One per group. There are approved medical packs available at the front desk for students with inhalers or medications.

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Make sure to arrive 30 minutes before your first tour time.
- Make sure chaperones and parents know what is expected of them prior to arriving.
- All students must be accompanied by an attentive adult at all times, including at the Gift Shop and Café.
- Group Ramadas are available to schools, call ahead to reserve.
- <u>Tour Ratio</u>: 4 adults and 16 students are optimal. There should never be less than 3 adults on a tour.
